**(1)** Local products are fresher, healthier and the money you spend stays right here in the community.



**(2)** Keeping local traditions alive and encourages sustainability. There's a reason they call it Yankee ingenuity and Loudon farmers do it best.



**(3)** Try something completely new. You can find all kinds of different foods and homemade items you won't find in your local store. Some items you can find right here in Loudon, NH are: chicken, duck, grass fed beef, fresh vegetables, rabbit, blueberries, apples, maple syrup, goat milk and more.



**(4)** Encourage green spaces. Buying local gives people a reason to farm, keeps spaces open and green and provides farming opportunities for future generations.



**(5)** Find new varieties of old favorites. Loudon farmers love to experiment with different varieties of fruits, vegetables and plants.



**(6)** Products from Loudon are not transported long distances creating a smaller carbon footprint.

**(7)** You know who you are buying from. Your Loudon farmer is your neighbor. Stop by, say, "Hi" and find out what farming is all about.



**(8)** Fruits and vegetables are picked in Loudon at the peak of perfection and sold within days (if not the same day) of being picked.
